Dear participants!

Join us in 2020 to celebrate the 135th anniversary of the P.N. Krylov Herbarium and the 170th birthday of Porfiriy Nikitich Krylov, an outstanding scientist, botanist, professor, corresponding member of the USSR Academy of Sciences, and founder of the Herbarium in Tomsk Imperial University. The Herbarium, created in Tomsk Imperial University in 1885, became in the short time a full-fledged scientific botanical institution, allowing large-scale scientific projects to be carried out on the basis of accumulated collections and a rich library of botanical literature. The Herbarium is the basis for fundamental research into the flora of Siberia and adjacent territories and into plant taxonomy. The famous *Flora of Altai and Tomsk Province* (1900–1914), *Flora of Western Siberia* (1927–1964), the well-known *Flora of Krasnoyarsk Territory* (1937–1983), and *Flora of Transbaikalia* (1966–1972) and *Flora of Siberia* (1987–2003) were created on the basis of collections of P.N. Krylov Herbarium. Herbarium collections were also fully used for the preparation of the fundamental *Flora of Siberia* (1987–2003). Scientific Botanical School established by P.N. Krylov on the basis of the Herbarium and the Department of Botany at Tomsk University covers the main fields of botanical research. the Department of Botany at Tomsk University covers the main fields of botanical research.

Participation

The conference provides for full and remote participation:

- **Full participation** plenary, sectional or poster presentations.
- **Remote participation** only the publication of manuscript in the Proceedings.

- September 1, 2020 payment deadline.

Registration Fee

Manuscript submission

Manuscripts should be submitted via the conference website **until August 15, 2020** after authentication and authorization through an individual account. In addition to online submission, please send your manuscript to herb.tsu@gmail.com (with notice "Herbarium2020").

Materials are accepted in Russian and English. For publications in Russian, the manuscript must be accompanied by an abstract in English. Figures and tables must be inserted into the text with legends, figures can also be provided in separate files. The text of the manuscript and figures are attached as ZIP or RAR files. Each conference participant can submit one manuscript of no more than three A4-paper pages.

Gidelines for authors for manuscript submission in English

- A4 format, 2 cm side margins.
- Title of the manuscript: Times New Roman, bold, centered (14 pt). The initials and family name of the author(s) and the title of the manuscript, centered (12 pt). **AAAAAA**
- Affiliation, city, country, e-mail, centered (10 pt).
- Abstract (10 pt).
- Keywords (about 10 words, 10 pt).
- Text of manuscript (11 pt).
- Latin names of taxa should be in italics. REFERENCES (10 pt).
- Figures and tables must be inserted into the text and accompanied by legends. Figures can also be provided as separate *.jpg, *.tif or *.png files with at least 300 dpi resolution.
